- **Committee Reports:**

  - Political Action – Jim Sullo reported on a Gov. Cuomo proposal to tighten gun confiscation rules for spousal abuse to include rifles in addition to pistols. The Gov. also proposed allowing convicted felons to vote.
- **Old Business:**
