Minutes of March 20, 2018 Meeting @ Blauvelt Firehouse

- Meeting commenced at 7:29 pm
- The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by the members followed by the invocation and moment of silence honoring our troops.
- Officers present – Ray Cascia (President), Dennis Scherer (VP) and Joe Chimenti (Treasurer)
- General attendance - 40 members signed in.
- The meeting minutes from February 2018 was read and approved.
- The Treasurer’s report for February 2018 was read and approved.

- **Committee Reports:**
 - Pistol Team - Robert Gordon reported that Pascack Valley won the last match at Northvale. The next and final match will be hosted by Pascack Valley.
 - Youth League – No new information. The upcoming Monday and Thursday night activities are still on schedule.
 - Range Report – The process of reporting issues as they occur is working well. Ray Cascia added to always be aware of their shooting angles particularly with smaller targets in close. Be sure to raise targets as high as possible. A work party will be established in April for ceiling tile replacement and repairs to the ductwork and ceiling drain channels.
 - Political Action – Jim Sullo mentioned that approximately 20% of NYS Pistol License holders did not register on the NYSP website and that those who mailed in the registration experienced over a 2 month delay followed by an open discussion among the membership. Jim also noted that in the Wrenn vs. DC lawsuit that rejected requiring a “good reason” for concealed carry is being used by the NYRPA in backing a NY resident’s suit.

- **Old Business:**
 - RCC Show – Rich Otto provided a recap of the RCC show. The club brought in approximately \$1,200 in donations and passed out many Youth Day flyers. Overall the show went very smoothly with sufficient help however going forward the schedule will be reviewed to provide backup if someone is out sick. Well-done Rich.
 - Friends of the NRA Dinner – The event will be held on Sunday 4/15/18. Note that the event will be protested. OPD & RCSD will be out front off property. We need to make sure this event goes on to make a statement to these protesters. We recommend that no firearms be brought to the event. Note that a group in Brooklyn was thrown out of two restaurants due to pressure from these kinds of groups.
 - Election Slate – The slate for officers for the vote at the April general meeting are as follows: Dennis Scherer, President; Mike Marucci, VP; Joe Chimenti, Treasurer and John Lombardi, Secretary. No nominations were submitted from the floor.
 - Joe’s Haberdashery – is open with the spring collection along with other items.
