Minutes of April 20, 2016 Meeting at Blauvelt Fire Department

1. The meeting opened at 8:04 pm.
2. The members recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
3. A moment of silence honoring our men & women in service was observed.
4. Officers Present: Tony Pascullo, President; Ray Cascia, Vice President; Randall Weishaar, Secretary; John Rutledge, Treasurer
5. General Attendance: 33 signed in.
6. The March 15th meeting minutes were read and accepted.
7. The Treasurer's report was read and accepted.
8. Committee Reports
 - **Pistol League** – Robert Gordon stated that the match was lost with Pascack Valley on 3/22. This resulted in a three-way tie for total matches won. We came out on top for Centerfire but Pascack Valley won the league championship.
 - **Youth League** – Turnout at the last youth shoot totaled seven (7) who were provided training along with the shoot.
 - **Range Report** – No new issues reported. Thank you from Ken Schwegler to the cleaning crew was made.
 - **Political Action** – Hillary is on the campaign trail promising another assault weapons ban. NYPD members were caught selling pistol permits to friends and bad guys. South Carolina will honor the Florida concealed weapon license only if the licensee is a resident of the state of Florida but since SC issues concealed carry licenses to non-residents these non-resident permits are not honored under Florida's reciprocity provision. Texas has permitted on campus carry and Alaska is trying to pass as well. Sandy Hook-a federal judge will allow a lawsuit to move forward against firearms firms even though federal laws protect gun manufacturers. California is proposing to ban FFLs. Maryland assault weapons ban was upheld by a lower court but the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 4th Circuit sent the law back to a lower court for review, but allows the existing ban to remain in place.
 - **Membership** – The club has received one resignation and one opening. We are working down the waiting list of ~13 and will send an update at the end of the month.
