Minutes of January 15, 2019 Meeting @ Blauvelt Firehouse

- The meeting commenced at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag recited by the members. A moment of silence honoring our troops was observed by the membership.
- General attendance - 29 members
- Officers present – Dennis Scherer (Pres), Mike Marucci (VP), John Lombardi (Sec’y), Joe Chimenti (Treas)
- Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved as submitted.
- The Treasurer’s report for December was read and approved as submitted: Total Assets , \$28,480.10
- **Committee Reports:**
 - Pistol Team Report – Joe Chimenti reported that Centerfire matches will begin on January 24th.
 - Youth League Reports – Joe Chimenti reported that there are mostly new shooters and the shoots are going well. Ed Rytter reported that his Youth Group will be starting up on Jan 28th.
 - Range Report – Dennis Scherer reported that there is range damage consisting of broken light fixture and hole in wall adjacent to Point 6. The security camera footage will be reviewed to determine the cause of the damage. Repairs to the range heat will be made as soon as the parts arrive.
 - Political Action – Jim Sullo reported on a bill in Albany that would make bump stocks illegal, increase the waiting period for firearm purchase to 10 days and a “red flag” provision that permits police or family members to petition a state court to order the temporary removal of firearms from a person who may present a danger to others or themselves.

 - Joe Chimenti reminded members of the PRGC logo clothing available for sale.
 - Dennis Scherer informed the membership that the application period for the Caccamo Award would begin shortly.
 - Rich Otto and Sal Massa are the chairpersons for the RCC Show. Members were asked to sign up for the various time periods over the duration of the event.
 - John Lombardi updated the membership on the upcoming Friends of The NRA Dinner to be held on Sunday, April 7th at the Clubhouse at Patriot Hills. Members were encouraged to attend this event and bring friends and family.

 - Mark Bromberg advised the membership of his upcoming defensive pistol classes to be held on January 19th. The morning session would be a basic class with an advanced session in the afternoon. Registration for each class is \$50 with all proceeds going to the Caccamo Fund.
 - John Lombardi asked the membership to attend a forum at the Clarkstown Town Hall on January 16th sponsored by the “Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America.”
